BENTON COUNTY HOUSEHOLDS may dispose of allowed specified materials **AT NO CHARGE** due to current subsidies in place. Materials generated by a non-household will NOT be accepted. Suspected non-household material will be rejected.

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS:

- ✓ **Household Hazardous Waste** – Subject to compliance with program rules below and acceptable material and volume limits. Refer to the very strict limitations of material types and allowed volumes on the back of flyer .
- ✓ **Household Electronics** such as radios, DVDs, VCRs, telephones, televisions, computers, monitors, printers, microwaves, etc.
- ✓ **Household Furniture** such as mattresses, couches, tables, chairs, etc.
- ✓ **Household Appliances** such as refrigerators, freezers, room air conditioners, dehumidifiers, icemakers, water heaters, ranges, washers, dryers, etc. **PLEASE NOTE: ALL FOOD PRODUCTS MUST BE REMOVED FROM REFRIGERATORS AND FREEZERS BEFORE DELIVERY TO THE SATELLITE.**
- ✓ **Large Yard Toys** such as large plastic toys, playground equipment. swing sets, etc.
- ✓ **Scrap Metal** such as grills, bicycles, metal fencing, metal lawn furniture, etc.
- ✓ **Up to four (4) passenger tires without rims** per household per month. NO OTHER TIRES WILL BE ACCEPTED AT SATELLITE LOCATIONS. Fees apply to extra passenger tires, tires on rims and larger tires which are collected ONLY at Centerton location.

UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS:

ONLY the items specified above which were generated by a household will be accepted through the Convenience Center. All other items will be unacceptable including but not limited to:

- × Household trash or garbage
- × Commercial, industrial or business waste
- × Construction/demolition debris and yard, windows, doors, etc.

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

- ◆ **EACH BENTON COUNTY HOUSEHOLD MAY DROP OFF THE MATERIALS AND VOLUMES SHOWN BELOW ONE TIME PER MONTH AT NO CHARGE.** Multiple visits in a calendar month are not allowed.
- ◆ **PLEASE HAVE MATERIAL AVAILABLE** where our staff can easily remove it from the vehicle.
- ◆ **USE CAUTION WHEN TRANSPORTING HAZARDOUS MATERIALS.** Place items inside a plastic tub to prevent spilling in your vehicle. Place leaking containers inside separate bins or buckets to prevent dangerous interaction with other materials.
- ◆ **DO NOT BRING EMPTY CONTAINERS!** Rinse containers according to package labels and recycle or dispose.
- ◆ **LATEX PAINT IS NOT HAZARDOUS.** Dry it by mixing with kitty litter, shredded paper, soil or sawdust. Place open cans of dried paint in your regular trash.
- ◆ **DO NOT MIX THE CONTENTS** of different containers or unknown materials together.
- ◆ **COMMERCIALY GENERATED MATERIAL CANNOT BE ACCEPTED** at the Household Hazardous Waste facility! All non-household material (from business, school, farm, churches, etc.) **MUST** be handled by a commercial hazardous waste company. Contact our office for a list of companies that operate in our area.

PLEASE NOTE! Volume limits may have changed!

Aerosols	8 cans
Anti-freeze	Up to 5 gallons
Ballasts (non PCB)	No Limit
Ballasts (PCB)	Up to 2 ballasts
Batteries (alkaline)	up to 1/2 gallon
Batteries (lithium)	No Limit
Batteries (NiCad)	No Limit
Bulbs (fluorescent)	8 bulbs (any length)
Bulbs (HID)	2 each
Bulbs (shattershield)	2 each
Cleaners (ammonia based)	Up to 1 gallon of liquid
Cleaners (water based)	Up to 1 gallon of liquid
Corrosive liquids (Pool, etc.)	Up to 1 gallon
Corrosive solids (Pool, etc.)	Up to 10 pound solid
Fertilizers (liquid)	Up to 1 gallon liquid
Fertilizers (solid)	Up to 20 pounds
Flammable liquids	Up to 2 gallons
Flammable solids	Up to 2 pounds
Oil-motor, gear, lube, cooking	Up to 5 gallons
Oil filters	Up to 4 filters
Paint - latex	Up to 5 gallons total
Paint - lead based	Up to 1 gallon total
Paint - oil based, stains, tars	Up to 5 gallons total
Pesticides - liquid	Up to 1 gallon
Pesticides - solid	Up to 5 pounds
Propane - 1 pound cylinders	Up to 5 cylinders
Propane - 20 pound tanks	1 tank
Sharps	Up to 1 gallon size
