

## 010000 - ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed bids for **TERMINAL APRON RECONSTRUCTION**, to be constructed for the City of Siloam Springs, Siloam Springs Municipal Airport, will be received at the City Administration Building, 400 North Broadway, Siloam Springs, Arkansas 72761 until 2:00 p.m. local time, Wednesday, April 7, 2010, at which time the bids shall be publicly opened and read aloud. Sealed bids can be mailed to PO Box 80, Siloam Springs, AR 72761, Attn: City Clerk-(bid name), but must be delivered to the City by the above time and date.

The project includes, but is not limited to the reconstruction of 5,300 square yards of terminal apron with a 6.5" concrete pavement and 9" subbase, and associated grading and drainage as shown on the plans and indicated in the specifications.

Bid documents (plans, specifications, proposal forms, and other contract documents) may be examined at Siloam Springs Municipal Airport, 20610 Smith Field Drive, Siloam Springs, AR 72761 (479-524-4103) and at the office of Garver, 1088 East Millsap Road, Fayetteville, AR 72703 (479-527-9100).

Bid documents may be purchased from Garver, attn John Grotjohn, for fifty dollars (\$50) per set plus shipping costs. NO REFUNDS of payment will be made and no partial sets will be issued.

Proposals shall be accompanied by a cashier's or certified check upon a national or state bank in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the total maximum bid price payable without recourse to the Owner, or a bid bond in the same amount from a reliable surety company, as a guarantee that the Bidder will enter into a contract and execute performance and payment bonds within ten (10) days after notice of award of Contract to him. Such bid guarantee shall be made payable to the City of Siloam Springs.

The successful bidder must furnish a performance and payment bond upon the form provided in the amount of one hundred per cent (100%) of the contract price from an approved surety company holding a permit from the State of Arkansas to act as surety, or other surety or sureties acceptable to the Owner.

Bidders must be licensed under the terms of Arkansas Code Annotation §§17-25-101, et. Seq.

Mechanics and laborers on the project shall be paid not less than the minimum hourly rates set out in General Decision Number AR080047. A copy of the minimum hourly rates is bound in the contract documents.

All bidders and proposers shall make good faith efforts, as defined by Appendix A of 49 CFR Part 26, Regulations of the Office of the Secretary of Transportation, to subcontract a minimum of 1.67 percent of the dollar value of the prime contract to small business concerns owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals (DBE).

The City of Siloam Springs reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive irregularities in the bids and bidding deemed to be in the best interests of the City of Siloam Springs, and to reject nonconforming, nonresponsive, or conditional bids.

Bids must remain in effect for 60 days after the bid opening date.
