TITLE: COMMERCIAL BURGLARY(s) ARREST
SILOAM SPRINGS, AR – 30 DECEMBER 2010

On 29 December 2010, Siloam Springs Police Department arrested a male juvenile, (age 14) in connection with a string of recent burglaries which have occurred in Siloam Springs. The subject gained entry into the buildings by breaking windows or prying open doors. The juvenile has been transported to JDC and is facing 6 felony counts of burglary, as well as criminal mischief and theft. A second suspect was arrested and cited for theft by receiving, relating to one of the burglaries. The arrests in this case resulted from information received from patrol officers who passed the information to Criminal Investigators. Investigators recovered a portion of the stolen cash and property from the subjects.

The subject has been implicated and arrested for the following burglaries:
