- .ACCEPTABLE ITEMS:**
- ✓ **Household Hazardous Waste** – Subject to compliance with program rules and acceptable material and volume limits. Refer to the very strict limitations of material types and allowed volumes on the back of flyer.
  - ✓ **Household Electronics** - must contain a circuit board and a cord - such as radios, media players (bluray, DVD, tape), telephones, televisions, computers, monitors, printers, microwaves, etc.
  - ✓ **Household Furniture** such as mattresses, couches, tables, chairs, etc.
  - ✓ **Large Household Appliances** - such as refrigerators, freezers, room air conditioners, dehumidifiers, icemakers, water heaters, ranges, washers, dryers, etc. **PLEASE NOTE: ALL FOOD PRODUCTS MUST BE REMOVED FROM REFRIGERATORS AND FREEZERS BEFORE DELIVERY TO THE CENTER.**
  - ✓ **Oversized Items** - common household items which will not fit inside a typical household trash container such as large playground equipment, oversized toys, car seats, etc.
  - ✓ **Metal Items** - items composed of at least 90% metal such as grills, bicycles, metal fencing, etc.
  - ✓ **Up to four (4) tires of any size** per adult resident per month. Fees apply to additional tires which are collected ONLY at Centerton location.

**UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS:**

ONLY the items specified above which were generated by a Benton County household will be accepted through the Convenience Center. All other items will be rejected including but not limited to:

- ⊘ **NO Household trash or garbage**
- ⊘ **NO Commercial, industrial or business waste**
- ⊘ **NO building materials of ANY kind**
- ⊘ **NO Yard waste, brush and leaves**

**ALL CITIZENS ARE REQUIRED TO UNLOAD THEIR OWN MATERIAL.

## HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

**BENTON COUNTY HOUSEHOLDS MAY DROP OFF THE MATERIALS AND VOLUMES SHOWN BELOW TO ONE OF OUR LOCATIONS ONE TIME PER MONTH AT NO CHARGE.** Multiple visits in a calendar month or visits to multiple convenience center locations are not allowed.

- ◆ **PLEASE HAVE MATERIAL AVAILABLE** so that our staff can easily remove it from the vehicle.
- ◆ **MATERIAL MUST BE TRANSPORTED IN DISPOSABLE CONTAINERS!** We will not return your containers. We will not pour up your material while you wait.
- ◆ **USE CAUTION WHEN TRANSPORTING HAZARDOUS MATERIALS.** Place items inside a plastic tub to prevent spilling in your vehicle. Place leaking containers inside separate bins or buckets to prevent dangerous interaction with other materials.
- ◆ **DO NOT BRING EMPTY CONTAINERS!** Rinse containers according to package labels and recycle or dispose.
- ◆ **LATEX PAINT IS NOT HAZARDOUS - DRY AND TRASH AT HOME.** Dry it by mixing with kitty litter, shredded paper, soil or sawdust. Place open cans of dried paint in your regular trash.
- ◆ **DO NOT MIX THE CONTENTS** of different containers or unknown materials together.
- ◆ **COMMERCIALLY GENERATED MATERIAL CANNOT BE ACCEPTED** at the Household Hazardous Waste facility! Federal and State laws require that all non-household material (from business, school, farm, churches, etc.) **MUST** be handled by a commercial hazardous waste company. Contact our office for a list of companies that operate in our area.
