Public Education Activities – 133 Public Education Activities...i.e. Smoke Alarm installation, tours of fire stations, fire safety in schools, wildland prescribed burns, etc.

Major accomplishments –

- Delivery of 3 new E-One fire trucks
- New ambulance remount
- Donation – purchase of UTV / EMS bikes (\$33,500)
- Grant – Purchase and install AEDs in all City facilities (\$10,000) – The FD will provide the training to all remaining City employees in CPR and the use of the AEDs
- Received CAAS Accreditation – In the EMS industry, this represents the “gold standard” in EMS system management and delivery. Less than 200 agencies nationwide and one of only 15 fire departments in the country to obtain.
