



SUMMER BASKETBALL: GENERAL INFORMATION

- League play will be on Tuesday nights starting July 10th
- The first game will start at 6:30pm
- All league games will be played at the Intermediate School New Gym
- Cost: \$250.00 / team
- There will only be one league
- Jersey colors will be picked by Captains as teams sign up. Each jersey must have a visible number.
- Team rosters and fees are due by 5pm on Monday, June 25th at the Parks and Recreation office: 401 W. University

Summer Basketball Rules

1. The league is open to players 16 years and older. Current High School, College or Professional Players are ineligible. ("Current" means the player was on an official team roster this academic year.)
2. Rosters are limited to 11 players including the captain.
3. Each player will be allowed 5 personal fouls.
4. A team must have at least 4 players at game time. A team must always have a least 4 eligible players to continue a game. Otherwise, it is a forfeit.
5. A player will be ineligible to play if alcohol is on his/her breath and will be asked to leave the premises. He/she will not be able to play in the following two games.
6. Teams must wear the same color jerseys with numbers on the front or back.
7. Games consist of two 20-minute halves with a running clock except during the last 2 minutes of the second half. The clock will stop the last two minutes of the game on a time-out, out-of-bounds, foul, free throw, etc. If a team is up by 15 points or more in the last two minutes, the clock will continue to run.
8. Each team has 2 time-outs per half that do not carry over to the next half. One additional time out is given for overtime play. (If a team has a time-out left from the second-half, they may use it during the overtime play.)
9. If the score is tied after regulation play, a maximum of two 3-minute quarters will be played to determine a winner. If the score is still tied after the extended periods, the 5 players on the court at the final horn from each team will shoot alternating free throws to determine the winner. If the score is still tied after the free throws, one player from each team will alternate free throws until a winner is determined.
10. No dunking or hanging on the rim/net is permitted at any time. A technical foul and \$25.00 fine will be issued for the violation. The backboard may be slapped if officials say it was done in a defensive attempt at the ball.
11. When a player receives a technical foul, that player must sit out the rest of the current game and the next game unless it is in the last five minutes of the game then the player sits out the following two games.
12. If a player receives a second technical foul in the season, he is out for the rest of the season and not allowed on the premises during the games.
13. Profanity of any kind will not be tolerated. Players and fans will be asked to leave the facility.
14. Fighting or attempting to fight before, during, or after the game, will result in that player being ejected for the rest of the season and the following season.
15. Any harassment by fans or players toward the referees will result in a forfeit by that team and may result in an ejection of that team for the season.
16. Only a protest of the eligibility of a player may be accepted. The protest must be made within 24 hours of the occurrence.
17. Games will begin on time. No grace period will be given.
18. Any willful destruction to the facility will result in immediate ejection from the league. Those involved will incur the costs.
19. Smoking is not permitted.
20. Rosters may only be changed the first 2 weeks of league play.
